How to Identify Potential Patients On Service



Potential NIV Patients



One way to find potential NIV patients is to look at your current patients on-service.

These tend to be patients on long-term therapy, but they do not have to be.



Potential NIV Patients



Look for patients with any increase in "visits". This could mean:

Increased visits to pulmonologist



OR

Increased hospital admissions



Potential NIV Patients



Look for patients with any increase in "oxygen". This could mean:

Increase in oxygen use at home

OR

Increase in tank delivery



Patient Conditions



Patients with the below conditions may potentially benefit from NIV therapy:

Common diagnoses

- Respiratory patients with recurrent readmissions (COPD, emphysema, chronic bronchitis, bronchiectasis, COVID + chronic disease)
- Neuromuscular disease/disorders of the diaphragm
- Restrictive Thoracic Disease (Kyphoscoliosis, Scoliosis, etc.)
- Obesity Hypoventilation Syndrome
